Robert Miller's father, World War II veteran Herbert Henry Miller, died in 1994. A month later, Robert and his mother discovered the Red Cross diary he had kept while a prisoner of war in Nazi Germany. It became the catalyst for Robert's quest to learn more about his father's war.

The result of that quest is this remarkable book, a story of terror, horrific despair, and Nazi depravity. But it is also a tale of survival against astonishing odds, of the deep bonds that develop between men at a time of war, and of choosing to leave hate behind.

The gripping and heartrending story of Herbert Henry Miller's war sheds needed light on issues that remain today at the forefront of our public discourse: the torture and treatment of POWS and the high psychological cost to individual soldiers of going to war.
